

Clear Your Record. Reopen Your Future.

One cleared record can reopen the door to a CDL, a license, or a union career.

- 1 Check your eligibility**
Dismissals are FREE to expunge. Some misdemeanors and Class E/C/D felonies qualify (DUI does not).
- 2 Finish the sentence**
All fines, fees, and restitution must be paid before you can file.
- 3 Pull your case record**
Go to the clerk's office in the county where the case happened.
- 4 File the petition**
File in that same court. Dismissals are free; conviction expungements run about \$100.
- 5 Can't expunge yet?**
Ask about a Certificate of Employability — it helps with jobs and licenses anyway.
